

Braunton Cricket Club Members' Code of Conduct

PURPOSE

The Purpose of this Code is to provide members, guests and visitors with guidance on the standards of behaviour that are expected of them while they are on the club premises so as to ensure everyone can enjoy amenities provided by the club in a safe, enjoyable and responsible manner.

COMMITMENT

The code demonstrates the shared commitment by the club management and members, guest and visitors in working together to achieving a social environment that enhances members, guest and visitors' enjoyment of the club's facilities and services.

EXPECTATIONS

- All members of Braunton Cricket Club are entitled to membership rights, and shall be treated equally and without discrimination, subject to the club constitution and this Code of Conduct.
- Members must treat one another with courtesy and respect at all times.
- Members must refrain from any harassing, bullying or abusive conduct. This is defined as behaviour which is likely to cause alarm or distress to another person or to make them feel uncomfortable.
- Members must observe the law and never do anything to bring the club into disrepute.
- Members must not act in a negative or destructive manner towards the club, its events or its elected committee. This does not preclude fair comment or opinion appropriately expressed.
- Members must respect the property and facilities provided by or through the club.
- Members are responsible for taking reasonable care over their health and safety and
 for assessing any risks to themselves or others of their participation in club events.
 Members shall observe any reasonable directions from the club, the event organizer
 or other responsible party in relation to their health and safety.

Any breaches of this Code of Conduct may form grounds for suspension or expulsion from the club in accordance with the club constitution.
